



*Uni-Spray Systems offers an extensive line of nozzles. Assemblies are currently available in 3 different generations (Mark I, Mark II and Mark III). These models provide unique aspects to meet the demanding working environments of our global customer base. Molding our own product in-house gives us the ability to quickly and efficiently meet tight delivery schedules.*

### **Mark I**

The original nozzle from Uni-Spray has been in the market place since 1987. The unique ball design that "pops" into place to secure the tip is one of the features of this assembly. A full range of color coding makes for quick visual identification of items.



### **Mark I QC**

A second generation of the original was introduced in 2002. The low profile design of this assembly along with the bayonet style tip release allows the customer to change tips quickly without fear of losing the spray pattern control that had been set up.



## Mark II

The Mark II family of nozzle adapters joined the Uni-Spray team in the early 1990's. This unit provides a low cost nozzle adapting mechanism for situations where directional adjustability of the tip is not required, but a need to be able to effectively remove the tip from the pipe is.



## Mark III

Another development in recent years from Uni-Spray is the Mark III threaded base. These threaded adapter bases allow the adjustable family of tips to be used on almost all pipe diameters. If the pipe can be drilled and tapped, an adjustable assembly can be mounted to it.



## Mark III QC

Using the full range of QC tips in our Mark III base was another logical progression. This combination creates one of the most versatile units with numerous applications.
